



**Definition of the International Organizing Committee (COIn) for the 2nd Biennale of Restoration
BRAU2**

Invitation addressed to the members of the Confederation CICOP Net and colleagues interested in participating in the event actively, living in Italy, Greece and Turkey

**The application must be sent by the end of January 2013
to the email italy@cicop.net**

For each city location, along the cultural axis of BRAU2 should be named a local manager (with its potential collaborators), by which the Net CICOP will sign an agreement that will summarize what is required and what is the offer of CICOP Net.

Preamble

The cities where we set up events and exhibitions of the BRAU2 are 12 (from Brindisi to Istanbul, see Annex). It's possible that there are variations (increment or decrease) in the number of participating cities to BRAU2, depending of new proposals which we will be received from colleagues or organizations of cities that flank the axis of BRAU2.

To each member of the International Organizing Committee (COIn) is request to:

- Identify the exhibition spaces and obtain the consent of the owner to its use. The exhibition spaces may be at universities, libraries, abandoned buildings used for exhibitions, etc.. The dimensions can be variable, from 100 to about 500 square meters for each city (300 posters will be displayed in each city).
- Maintain contact with the local authorities (municipality, province, region, schools) and get the patronage of the Municipality.
- Assist in the preparation (assembly and disassembly) of the exhibition, which will be done by local staff or
- Propose to BRAU2 collateral events, which can be: a) conferences b) initiatives involving school children on the theme of "migration and multiculturalism", or, technical meetings and partnerships with other cultural activities that will take place on site in the same time as the BRAU2.
- Provide information as brochures to be distributed locally.
- Encourage local designers, highly skilled, to expose their restoration work, which are related to their territory. The participation of these designers will be free of the participation fee to BRAU2.

The offer of the Confederation CICOP Net is summarized as follows:

- Members of the COIn will be mentioned in all the brochures and invitations of the various manifestations of BRAU2: invitations, conferences, opening ceremony and closing.

- Members of the COIn may be activated in order to have sponsorship from local and national organizations and companies. Any funds collected by them, will be managed independently and aimed at the success of the exhibition.
- Members of the COIn will be invited to attend the opening ceremony of the BRAU2 in Brindisi, or, at the closing ceremony in Istanbul.
- Members of the COIn and their collaborators can participate, free of charge, to all the manifestations of the Confederation CICOP Net, both in Italy and abroad, for the full year 2013 (Congresses, seminars, courses).
- Members of the COIn they can propose themselves to get official positions within the Confederation, in the next General Assembly that will take place in Istanbul in concomitance with the closing ceremony of BRAU2.

Notes:

- The exhibition material will be printed at the headquarters of the CICOP Net, and will arrive at the exhibition place, which will be indicated by the manager of the COIn, one week before the start of BRAU2.
- If requested by the manager of the COIn, could participate in organizing the exhibition, a trainee of the Confederation CICOP Net.
